The SEA Gas is a 680km pipeline from Port Campbell in Victoria to Adelaide in SA. Fyfe played a major role in the successful completion of the project. We carried out the initial survey to locate the pipeline route including geotechnical surveys, ecological surveys and heritage surveys, property boundary surveys, cadastral surveys, easement surveys, pipeline alignment drawings, realignment surveys, pipeline GIS, construction surveys and as built surveys.

The key outcome was the completion of surveys that enabled property acquisition and licence approval for the commencement of construction by the due date of August 2002 (12 months after commencement). Fyfe were able to complete large numbers of property surveys and pipeline alignment drawings and prepared easement plans for over 600 properties over a short period of time. Fyfe worked through all phases of the project from the initial inception, through the design phase, onto construction and then commission of the pipeline.
